## Exploration Yukon & Nevada

Gold & Vanadium

Stina's 2011 focus is the development of the **Dime** and **Kodiak Gold properties in the Yukon**, in addition to the continued development of the **Bisoni McKay Vanadium Property** in Nevada.

Stina enters its second season of developing its **Dime Gold Property** in the Yukon, approximately 75 km south of Dawson City. This **Shawn Ryan** property hosts a former Teck target and had soil sampling, trenching and diamond drilling done during 2010.

The property now contains **three major anomalies in a system that stretches more than 4.5 km**. In 2010 Stina expanded the property by staking an additional 180 claims surrounding, and also conducted the first ever **core drilling** on the property. Additionally, a 2009/10 soil program returned elevated gold in soil values up to **6.08 grams per tonne**.

Stina's **Kodiak Gold Property**, located 115 km south of Dawson City, boasts **tie-on claims on the south side of the Kinross White Gold Property** and directly north of the **Kaminak Latte property**. This **Shawn Ryan property** straddles Thistle Creek which was the richest placer gold-producing creek in the area giving up more than 63,000 ounces of placer gold since the turn of the 20th century. The 2009/10 soil sampling has identified a northwest-trending soil anomaly to a strike length of four km and defined a second parallel 4 km long anomaly, with **values up to 856.8 ppb gold**, to the southwest. In addition 383 m of trenching has helped identify future drilling targets.

Stina is committed to not only taking its **Bisoni McKay Vanadium Property** towards a feasibility study, but also positioning it as a vanadium supply for green technologies, particularly emerging **vanadium battery markets**, in addition to traditional steel-making industries. A total of 36 Core and RC holes have been drilled on the property, establishing approximately **20 million tons** of indicated and inferred vanadium pentoxide at an average grade of 0.39% in an NI 43-101 resources estimate on only a fraction of the mineralized zone. This property has several inherent advantages over other vanadium properties

as it is potentially **open-pittable**, contained in soft host rock **close to surface**, potentially **leachable**, and located in mining-friendly Nevada. Capital and direct costs are expected to be lower than other existing vanadium producers.



### Strategic Focus for 2011

- Enhance shareholder value through significant exploration and development of its properties
- Maintain a favorable share structure
- Attempt to further identify correlations in Kodiak and Kinross White Gold claim structure
- Refine targets on the Kodiak and Dime Gold Properties and expand exploration, including diamond drilling
- Research and acquire additional properties of merit and potential.
- Further develop the Bisoni McKay vanadium property in order to attract alternative energy producers, such as cutting edge energy storage applications and redox battery manufacturers

# Dime Gold Property - Yukon

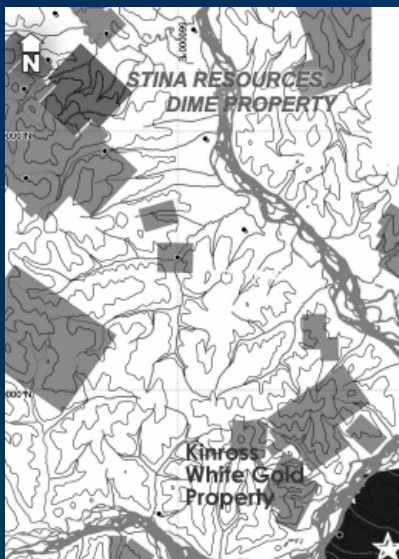
*Located 75km south of Dawson City in the Ten Mile Creek Area*

2010 soil sampling and trenching indicate **three large anomalies running** east west on the property, that appear to be **structurally controlled**, and potentially the largest system (**over 4.5 km**) in the area after **Kaminak's Coffee and Kinross' White Gold** systems. **Soil values** as high as **6.08 g/tonne**

Contains part of a former **Teck target** and exploration area of Teck and Fjordland in the 1990s and 2000s, and staked by **Shawn Ryan**.

Five **core holes** drilled in 2010 totaling 657 m from three separate drill pads, with mineralization in each hole, including 0.71g/t over 32 m.

**Budget of between \$1.5 and \$2M for 2011**, doubling the soil grid, extending trenching another 2,500m, flying geomagnetic survey, and drilling another 15 to 20 core holes.



# Kodiak Gold Property - Yukon

*Located 115 km south of Dawson City in the White Gold District*

Tie-on Claims to **Kinross (formerly Underworld) White Gold Property** and directly north of **Kaminak's Latte and Coffee Properties**.

Anomalies are at the end of a high magnetic trend that extends from **Kinross White Property**, with soil values as high as **856.8 ppb gold**

Elevated nickel values in soil which occur either with or in the proximity of anomalous gold zones indicating underlying **mafic or ultramafic** rocks.

Historical placer gold production on **Thistle Creek** bounding north side of Kodiak claim block, and anomalous silt (stream) sediment values on Kodiak from GSC surveys add to strong potential.



# Bisoni McKay Vanadium Property - Nevada

*Located 380 km east of Reno in the Eureka and Nye Counties*

Initial metallurgical studies indicate up to over **90% recovery of vanadium pentoxide (V2O5)** using an acid pug/leach operation.

**NI 43-101 qualified** indicated and inferred resources of approximately 20M tonnes of vanadium pentoxide (V2O5), expandable in all directions.

**5 core and 36 RC holes** indicating extensive and consistent mineralization with good grade, defining a consistent mineralization zone.

Potentially **open-pittable** with soft, easy to grind host rock close to surface.

Potentially **leachable recovery**, and thus **lower direct and capital costs**.

Potential supply for **green technologies** such as **Redox Battery**.
